Enrollment Deposit – minimum amount required with application (this is credited against total balance due) \$600 US
Pay the deposit with enrollment, then pay balance of tuition and all other fees upon receipt of confirmation statement from Camp.

Tuck Account Fees

Tuck Fee (Tuck covers campers' additional expenses during a session. Pay the correct amount with your early bird fees.)

For ages 7, required Tuck Deposit for Mic-Macs One-Weeker	\$200 US
For ages 7 – 12, required Tuck Deposit for two-week sessions	\$400 US
For ages 8 – 12, required Tuck Deposit half or full season	\$500 US
For ages 13 – 14, required Tuck Deposit, anticipates extended canoe trips	\$600 US
For age 15+ AA campers, required Tuck Deposit (an additional transport fee will apply TBD)	\$600 + TBD

Camper charges are deducted from this deposit, which you pay along with your tuition fees. A final statement is sent in the Fall.
Any unused portion is refunded. Tuck charges include a required 5% of tuition Ontario Parks fee per Camper.

Registration Terms and Conditions, 2019

1. Registrations must be received with full payment or \$600 us / cn deposit, and parent signature.
2. Payments for U.S. and overseas campers using this form must be made by check or transfer in US funds.
3. In the event of withdrawal or cancellation, 50% of tuition balance is refundable until March 1, 2019. Tuition is non-refundable after March 1, when operating expenses are fixed for the summer. No credit is given for late arrival or early withdrawal.
4. Parents agree to make tuition payments promptly. Late payments are subject to a service fee of \$100 per month. For standard enrolls, a Camper's place can not be held if balance of payment is not received by March 1. Priority must then be given to Wait List Campers.
5. Campers may extend their stay to 3 1/2 or 7 weeks, subject to availability. A revised tuition bill will be payable.
6. Base tuition fees do not include 13% HST tax, or Tuck fees. AA campers are subject to extra trip charges for long trips.
7. Camp offers limited bus / airport transportation services. Transportation is billed through your son's Tuck account.
8. Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen property. Avoid sending expensive items and please label all belongings.
9. Registration Credit – Families registering more than one sibling will receive \$100 us/cn credit for each additional child enrolled. Credit will be applied to the final expense statement at summer's end. Family Camp and One-Weeker excluded.
10. Referral Credit – Families referring a new family that signs up a Camper will receive a \$100us/cn credit per Camper. Credits will be applied to the final expense statement at summer's end. Family Camp and One-Weeker excluded.
11. Camp Pathfinder assigns campers to an age-group or 'tribe' based on their age as of July 1 of the summer sessions.
12. Camp Pathfinder maintains a Code of Conduct for campers, and reserves the right to assess a Camper's behavior, to revise a Camper stay, or to dismiss a Camper early, when it is deemed necessary in the interest of the child and Camp Pathfinder. No refunds shall be given in these cases. Parents agree to provide full information on Campers in advance.
13. Parent Permission is given herewith to use photos/video of your child for Camp archival records or promotional purposes.

I desire my child to participate in the full camp program and all activities including canoe tripping, unless I advise the Camp as to any restriction in writing. In consideration of the acceptance of my child into the camp program, I hereby release Camp Pathfinder, its officers and employees, from all claims arising from my child's participation in camp activities. I authorize the camp to secure medical treatment for my child when appropriate. If for any reason my child requires medical attention beyond that furnished by the camp, I agree to be responsible for any expenses incurred. I acknowledge that the camp activities and any medical treatment will be performed in the Province of Ontario, and that the Courts of Ontario shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claims, legal dispute or cause of action arising out of my child's stay at Camp Pathfinder. I hereby agree that if I commence any legal proceedings, they will be held only in the Province of Ontario, and I hereby irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Ontario.

I have read and agree to all of the above terms and conditions of registration and payment of the total camp bill to be applied to the above camper's account. I understand that my signature below and payment enclosed are required to confirm my son's enrollment.
