- 1 pr. highest-quality waterproof/breathable raingear (jacket and pants required)
- 1 pr. base layers crewneck and pant -- light, warm, breathable (smartwools preferred)
- 1 high quality mid-layer fleece or shelled synthetic fill jacket (high quality required)
- 1 pr. Fleece pants or lined windproof track pants
- 1 pr. light gloves and a warm knit hat are required for AA campers.
- 1 Thermarest 'TrailLite' or 'Prolite' mattress pad for AA campers.
- 1 pr. Waterproof campsite ankle height shoes (rubber and/or neoprene), Muck Boots

^{*}Make sure your senior camper has a new or like-new dry bag that does not leak.
